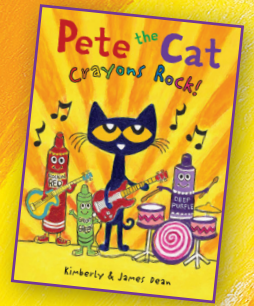




Pete the Cat
